

Need Help Complying with EPA's sVGP?

On 19 December 2014, all commercial vessels under 79 feet, **INCLUDING FISHING VESSELS**, will be subject to enforcement of the EPA's Small Vessel General Permit (sVGP). Subject vessels will be required to have **ON FILE** a Permit Authorization and Record of Inspection (PARI) with the EPA as part of the compliance process for managing effluent. This includes:

- Fuel Management
- Engine and Oil Control
- Solid and Liquid Waste Management
- Deck Washdown and Runoff and Above Water Line Hull Cleaning
- Vessel Hull Maintenance
- Graywater
- Fish Hold Effluent
- Ballast Water
- Overboard Cooling Water Discharge

Do you own, operate, or manage one of these previously exempt vessels? Don't be lulled into a false sense of security by lack of prior enforcement. First offense for noncompliance "shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$10,000, or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or both."
